

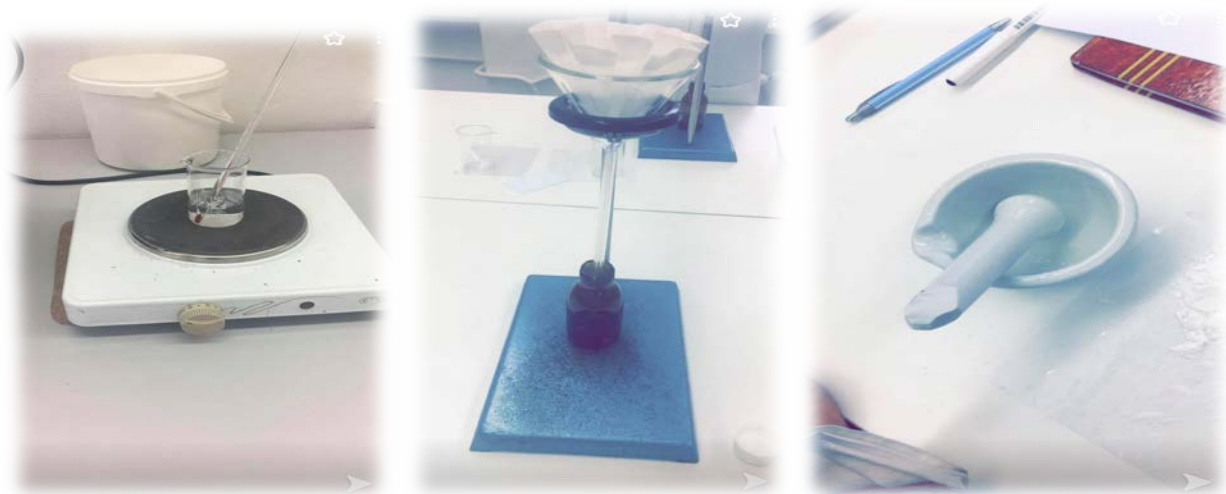


### **My vocational education - My best choice**
